Granular Potash application feeds the root system and helps the roots grow deeper & stronger and more tolerant to drought, insects and disease.

Palm Tree service includes applying granular 13-3-13 mix to all non-native palm trees. Drenching and Injections are not included in this service. Injections vary in price between \$25.00 and \$35.00 per tree depending on size and type of injection. Drenching for Boron runs between \$25.00 and \$30.00 per tree depending on the size. Total tree count: Pygmy Date-114, Foxtail-71, Royal-14, X-Mas-55, Queen-24 and Misc-10. We do not treat hardwood trees or Cabbage/Eureka palm trees.
